February 25, 2011 - February 29, 2024

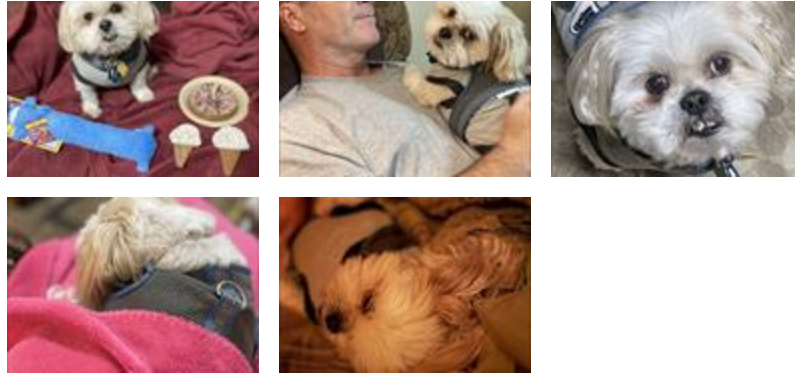
